About the Program

Your clinical team may ask if you would like to enrol in the **Gyne ChemoRads Remote Patient Monitoring (RPM) Program**. You may be eligible for this online program if you are getting concurrent chemotherapy and radiation for your gynecological cancer.

This program allows your health care team to track your symptoms during and after treatment. You will be asked to fill out a symptom questionnaire in your **myUHN** each weekday. The questionnaire allows your healthcare team to see how you are feeling while you are at home. By tracking your symptoms, your care team can help you manage them if they become worse.

Your healthcare team may follow up with you by phone if they are concerned about your symptoms.

You will be part of this program while you are on treatment, and for about 6 weeks after (about 12 weeks total).

Some days you will see other questionnaires in your **myUHN** for the program that you can choose to complete.

Go to the **Apple Store** for iOS or the **Google Play Store** for Android and search for **myUHN**



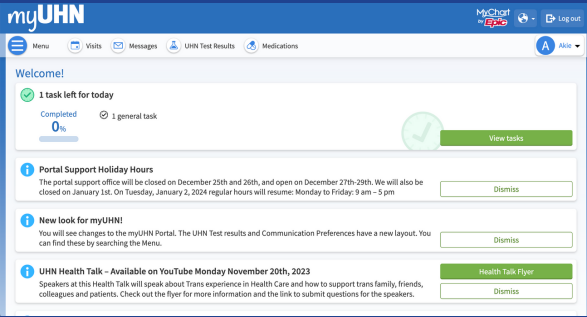
Download the **MyChart** app

Click on each task in your **myUHN** to open it and follow the instructions to complete each task.

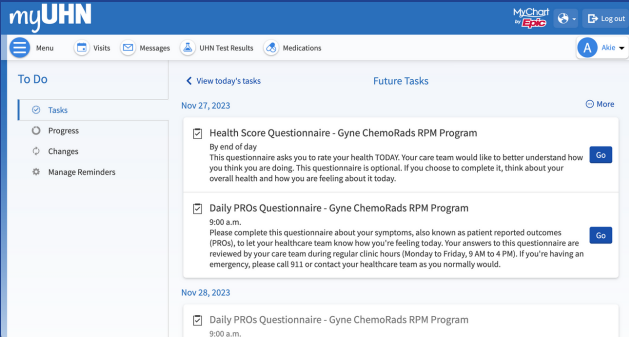
When you have more than one task, you can complete them in any order.
