

How to Find Education Materials through myUHN Patient Portal (App Version)

In this guide, you will learn **how to find patient educational materials** assigned to you by your care provider through your myUHN Patient Portal account.

- 1) Log in to your myUHN Patient Portal account using your **username and password**.

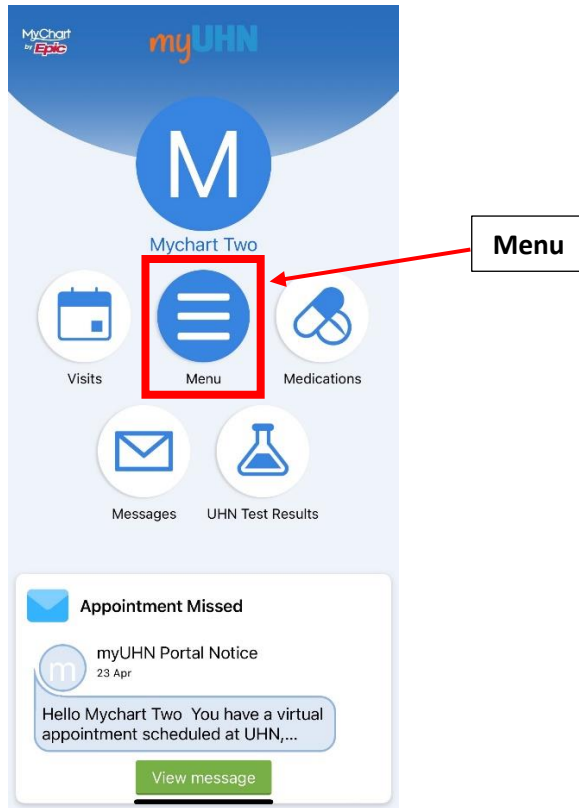

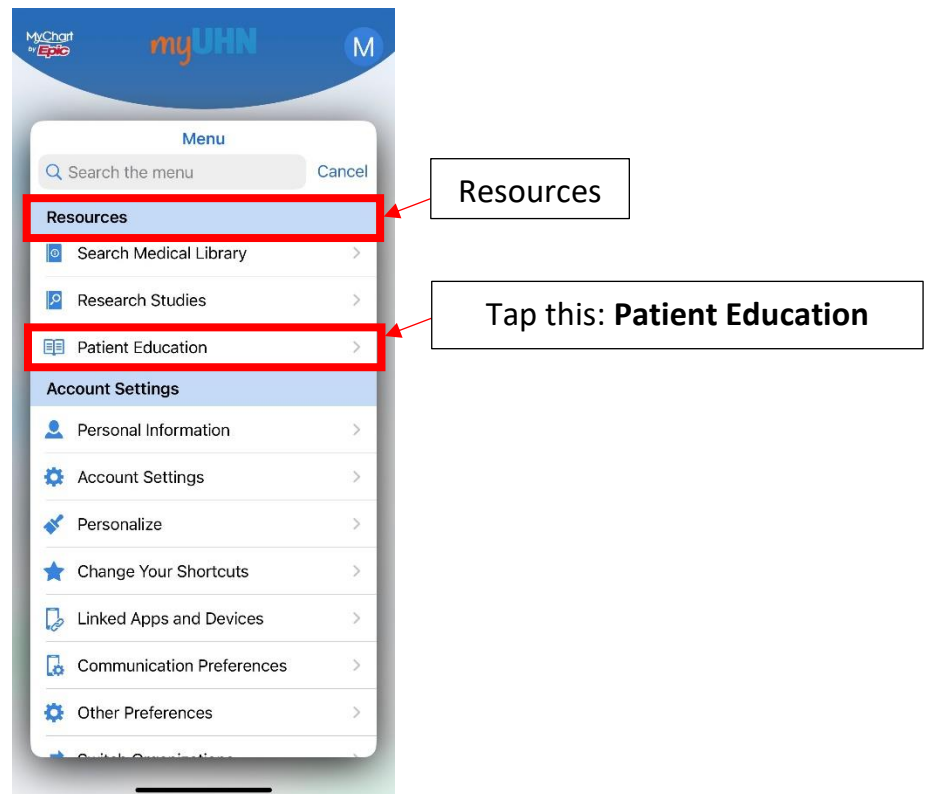
- 2) After logging in, you will see your home page. Tap **Menu** to navigate to other sections.
- 3) To find educational material assigned to you, tap **Menu** and swipe up to find **Patient Education** in the Resources section. You will be taken to a new page.



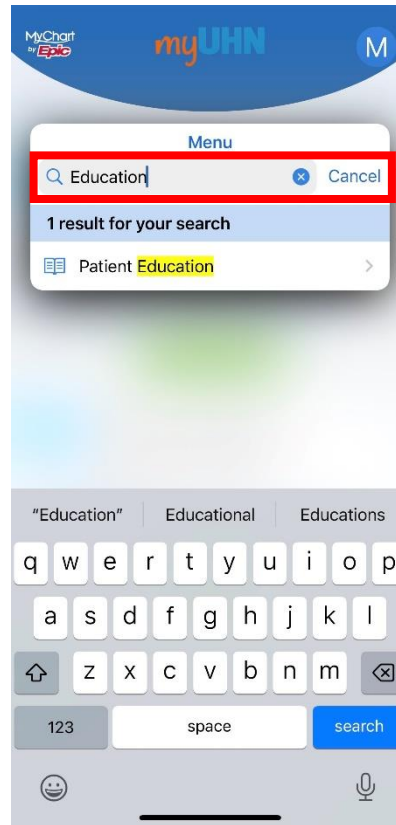
Tapping **Menu** will open a panel with a list of categories and subcategories.



Swipe up to find Patient Education in the Resources section.



You can also use the **search bar** at the top of the Menu. Type **Education** into the search bar and tap the Patient Education result below.



Type **Education** in the search bar to make the **Patient Education** button appear.

- 4) On the **Patient Education** page, you can view the education materials assigned to you. You can open any material by tapping the **Open education** button below the education resource.

Tap **Back** to go back to the Menu.

Tap **Close** to go back to the Menu.

Open education. This button can be seen across all education material.

You can go back to the Menu by tapping the **Back** or **Close** button at the top of the screen.

- 5) When you open an education resource, you will see the list of pages for this item. You can tap on each page to see more information.

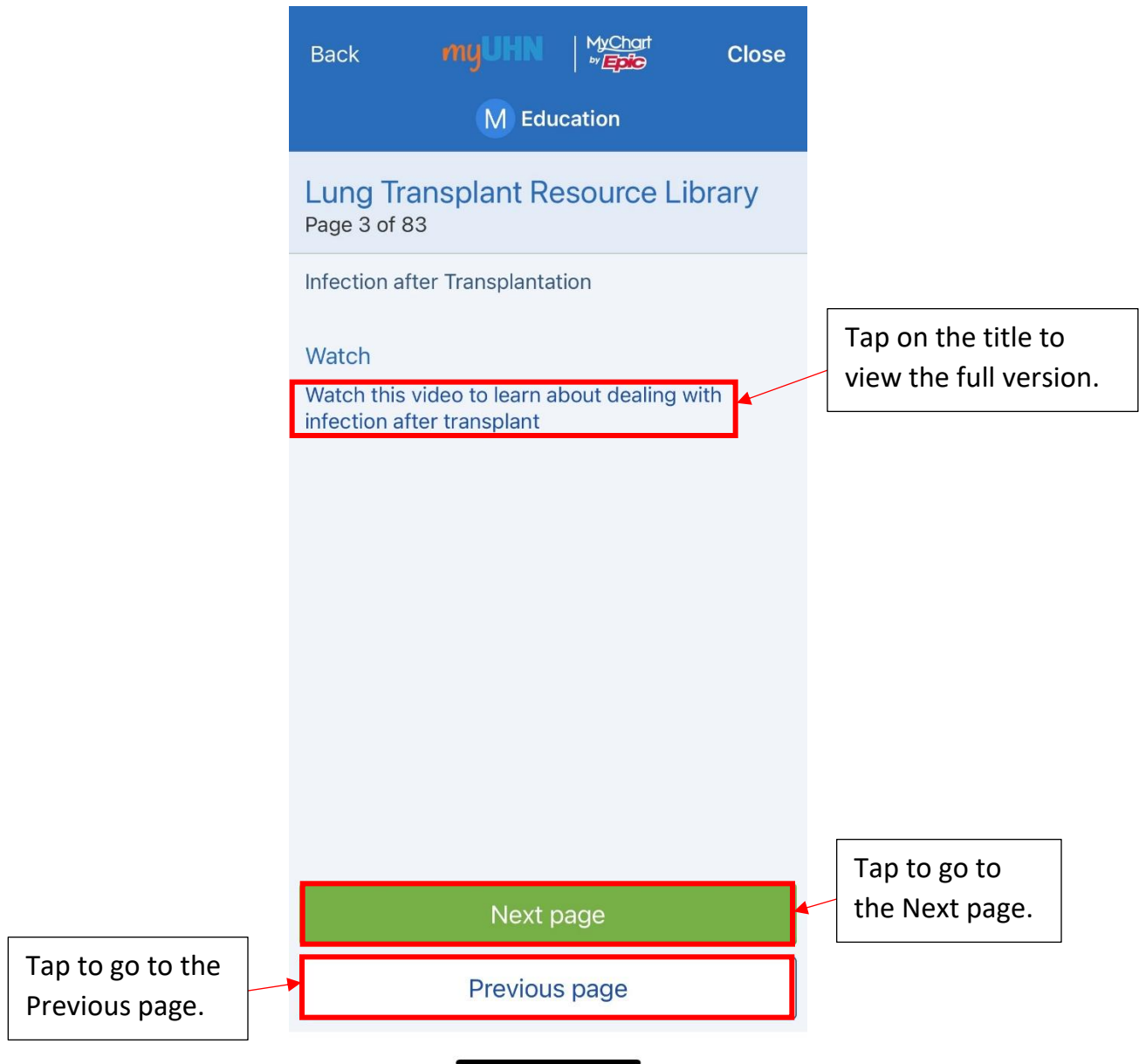

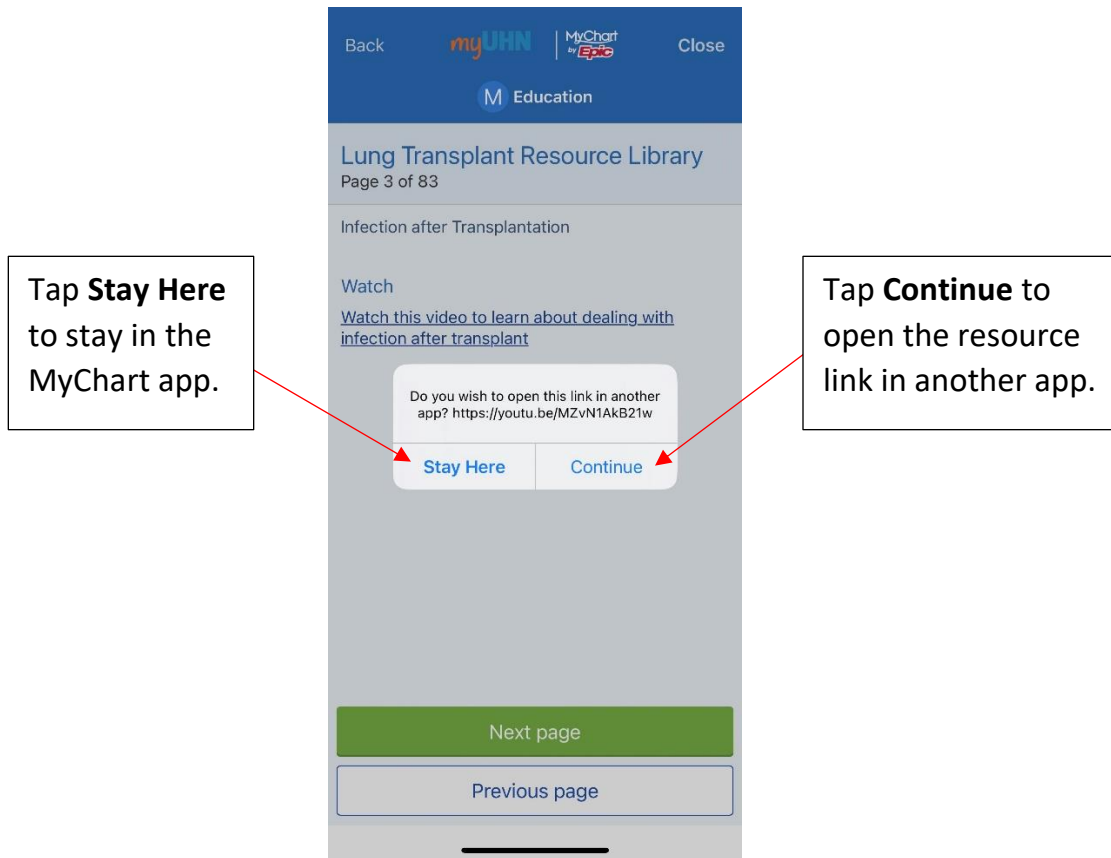
You can also return to the assigned education material by tapping **Back** or return to the Menu by tapping **Close**.

- 6) After selecting a page, you will see an overview of the information. Tap the **title** of the resource to view the full version.

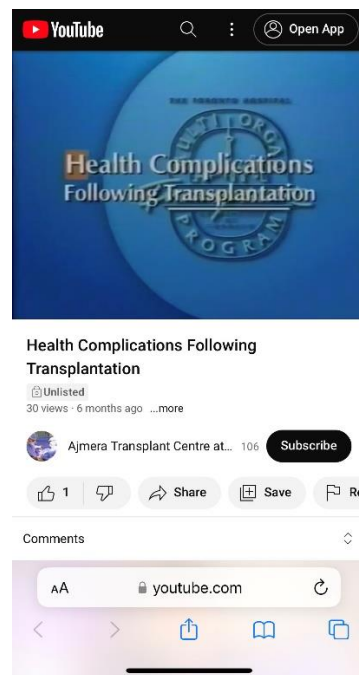
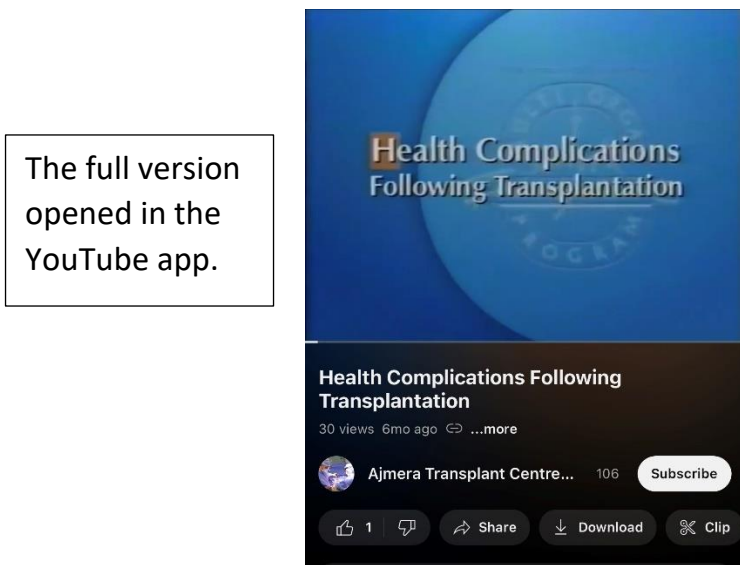


You can go to the next page of this education resource by tapping **Next page** or return to the previous page by tapping **Previous page**.

When you tap the title of the resource, a pop-up will appear asking if you wish to open the resource in another app. If you want to view the resource, tap **Continue**. If you want to remain in the MyChart app, tap **Stay Here**.
